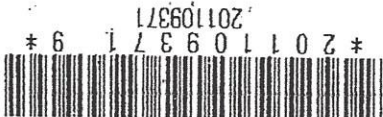

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING PROPERTY -

YVETTA J. ROBINSON

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Hopkins

Park, Kankakee County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: That this President and Board of Trustees find as follows:

- (a) A Petition has been filed with the Village Clerk and presented in proper form to the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Hopkins Park, requesting that the territory described in Section 2 of this Ordinance be annexed to the Village of Hopkins Park, Kankakee County, Illinois;
- (b) The aforesaid Petition is in proper form under oath, signed by all owners of record of all the land within the territory, there being no electors residing within or on said territory;
- (c) That the Village of Hopkins Park does not provide fire protection or a public library. The territory is in Pembroke Township and there is a township highway adjacent thereto, and therefore notice of the proposed annexation has been served upon and given to the Township Supervisor and the Township Clerk, in the time and manner provided by law, but no notice is required to be served on any fire protection district or public library district;
- (d) An affidavit that notice has been served as provided in Section 1(c) is attached hereto and hereby made a part hereof;
- (e) Such territory described in Section 2 is within the unincorporated portion of Kankakee County and not within the corporate limits of any municipality, but is contiguous to the Village of Hopkins Park, Kankakee County, Illinois, a municipality existing under the laws of the State of Illinois.

Section 2: That the territory hereinafter described be and is hereby annexed to the

Village of Hopkins Park, Kankakee County, Illinois pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/7-1-1; 65

ILCS 5/7-1-8:

LOT 83 MOSCICKIS AND KARLOCK SUBDIVISION BEING A RESUBDIVISION OF LOTS 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 9, 10, THE SOUTH 33 FEET OF LOT 11, THE SOUTH 33 FEET OF LOT 17, 18A, THE EAST 66 FEET OF THE SOUTH 326.7 FEET OF LOT 18B, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33 AND 34 OF COUNTY BOARD OF SCHOOL TRUSTEE'S SUBDIVISION OF SECTION 16, TOWNSHIP 30 NORTH, RANGE 11 WEST OF

THE SECOND PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, IN KANKAKEE COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

together with any adjacent street or highway required by law to be annexed pursuant to the provisions of 65 ILCS 5/7-1-1 and 65 ILCS 5/7-1-8.

The annexation of the above-described territory shall extend to the far side of any

adjacent highway and shall include all of every highway within the said property.

Section 3: That the Village Clerk is hereby and herewith instructed to record with the

Recorder of Deeds of Kankakee County, Illinois, and to file with the County Clerk of Kankakee

County, Illinois:

(a) A copy of this Ordinance certified as correct by the Clerk of the Village of

Hopkins Park; and

(b) A plat of the land included in this annexation, as required by law, said plat

to be attached to the aforesaid certified copy of this Ordinance.

Section 4: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its

passage and approval as required by law.
