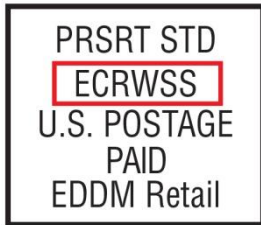

Pembroke Township and the Village of Hopkins Park experienced a water outage for approximately 45 minutes in October. What happened? One of the two pumps that generate water for the community failed. Village personnel and the Township Supervisor responded to assess the situation. The village Emergency Operation Plan (EOP) was initiated, and water was restored. Superior Pumping Services was called to pull motor for repair. This is an example of how the Emergency Management Plan (EMP) developed during this administration works.
